MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELING AND TREATMENT

Licensed therapists provide individual, group, and family therapy, as well as play therapy for children. As a supplement to counseling, psychiatrists prescribe and manage medications when needed, and trained peer specialists provide guidance and support based on their lived experiences.

COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES

This suite of services provides a range of assistance for adults, children, and families. Adults with medical, mental health, and/or substance use issues receive help navigating multiple service systems and accessing resources. Seniors benefit from home-based counseling and referrals. Children with mental health, substance use, medical, and other needs, as well as their parents/caregivers, receive assistance that includes navigating service delivery systems, peer support, and advocacy. Families become strengthened through parental skills trainings, family support groups, supervised visitation, and counseling.

ALCOHOL AND SUBSTANCE USE TREATMENT & PREVENTION

Credentialed counselors and social workers provide individual, family, and group counseling. Psychiatrists provide evaluations and prescribe medications, including treatment for opioid use. CoveCare Center offers prevention education in Putnam County schools, raises awareness about substance use issues, and informs the public about local resources.

PROSper – PERSONALIZED RECOVERY-ORIENTED SERVICES FOR PEOPLE ENGAGED IN REHABILITATION

PROSper helps people with serious mental health issues to recover, heal, and gain their independence. Services include goal-oriented counseling, classes, individual counseling, medication management, vocational counseling, and specialized services for people with both mental health and substance use issues.

CoveCare Center Honors

Our Veterans & the PFC Joseph P. Dwyer Vet2Vet Program of Putnam County

We come together tonight to honor our veterans and the PFC Joseph P. Dwyer Vet2Vet Program of Putnam County. The program's mission is to assist all veterans of Putnam County and their families through free, confidential and anonymous vet-to-vet outreach services, with the goal of utilizing the unique connection between veterans to help foster relationships and direct the veterans to the services they may need.

The program was founded in memory and honor of the late Joseph P. Dwyer, a soldier in the United States Army who served in Iraq and later died of an accidental overdose in his home after a long battle with Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD). The Putnam County program is coordinated by Iraq war veteran John Bourges, who will be accepting the Imagine Award on behalf of the program and all veterans.

Overseen by the New York State Office of Mental Health, the program is administered locally through the Mental Health Association in Putnam County and the Putnam County Veterans Service Agency. The program is provided to veterans in need with no restrictions regarding discharge status or service dates.



"One of the most important aspects of the Dwyer Vet2Vet Program is unrestricted access to our services," mentioned Bourges in an interview with Putnam County Online. The Dwyer Vet2Vet Program does not apply any restrictions regarding service length of discharge status. Any former military professional can take part in the Vet2Vet program, and we encourage anyone who is struggling with isolation, depression, PTSD, or the day-to-day challenges of acclimating to civilian life to contact us. We are here for you."

In addition to support groups and outreach, the program recently launched a 24-hour warm line (914-519-8097) for former military personnel who have a need to speak with a veteran peer counselor.
